**Kevin Freeman** is coming to Southern Oregon! Be inspired and start the new year with this master horseman and teacher - a 3 time Olympian & medalist, 2 time Pan American Games medalist, and twice National Champion. In December, 2009 Kevin was named to the USEA Hall of Fame. He is a supportive, articulate, and inspiring clinician with a strong emphasis on basic, classical principles of jumping. And, he believes in fun too! The clinic will be suitable to hunter, jumper, equitation, and eventing riders of all ages and levels.

**Sessions of 2 hours** each will be held **each day** First session at 9 am. Specific times/levels will be confirmed. A limit of 6 riders per session will assure personal attention.



The fitness of horses (and riders) will be taken into consideration since most of us are just getting back into the saddle after the holidays.



Heights of jumps will be established based on participants. Beginners are welcome, starting with cross poles and gymnastics. Intermediate and Advanced sessions will be offered; heights to be advised.



A pony session is being planned.
